SAFETY INFORMATION

Safety Notes

- If the ceramic cooking surface cracks, switch off the BBQ immediately and contact customer support. Do not use until inspected.
- The surface of the BBQ will become extremely hot during use and will retain heat after use. It can cause burns – be careful.
- Never leave the BBQ unattended while in use.
- Do not use the BBQ for any purpose other than cooking food.
- Only responsible adults should use this BBQ. Children or pets must never be left unsupervised around the BBQ.
- Do not move the BBQ while it is in use. Always switch off and disconnect from the power supply before removing or moving the docking unit.
- Allow the BBQ to cool before moving or cleaning it.
- Do not immerse the BBQ in water or expose it to rain.
- Do not connect, operate, or disconnect the BBQ with wet hands.
- If the power cord or cable is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, a service agent, or a licensed technician.
- Do not alter or modify the BBQ. Repairs must be performed by a qualified technician
- Metal utensils such as forks, knives, or spatulas should not be left on the cooking surface as they can become hot.
- This BBQ is not intended for commercial use.
- The BBQ is not dishwasher safe.
- use may cause injury, damage, or death. Follow all instructions carefully.

- The BBQ has integrated short-circuit protection and over-temperature protection.

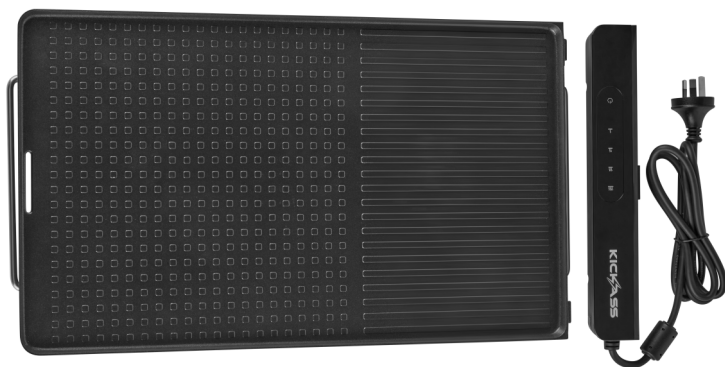

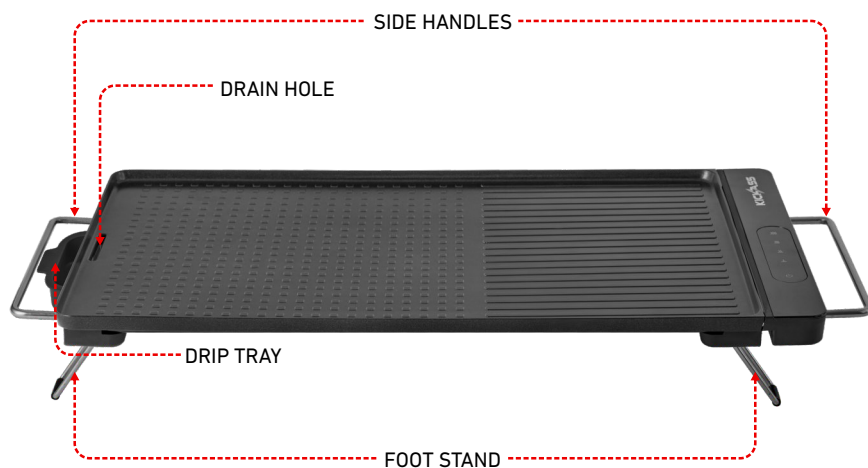

PRODUCT OVERVIEW



USING THE ELECTRIC BBQ GRILL

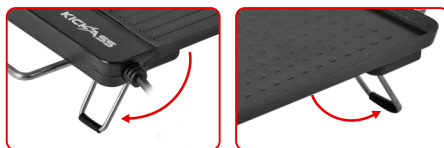
1. Remove the plate and the power interface base from the carry bag.



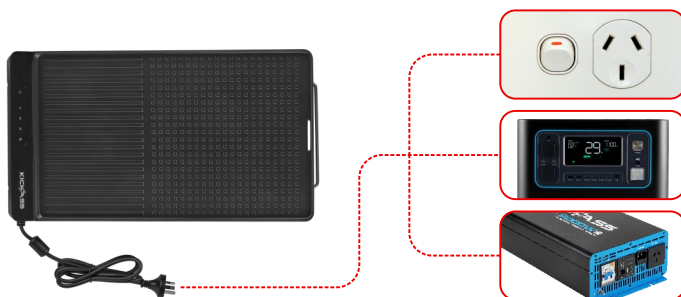
2. Pull the side handle of the plate on both sides and extend. Attach the base to the right side of the grill by pressing on both sides of the locking tabs. Ensure there is no space between the plate and the base.



3. Unfold the foot stand on both sides and place the grill on a flat and stable surface.



4. Connect the grill to an AC power source that can supply at least 1500W, for example a standard wall power outlet, power station, or pure sine wave inverter.



Note: When using a pure sine wave inverter, make sure it is rated at 1500W or higher. Using a lower-rated inverter may cause the grill to operate unpredictably or not start properly.

5. Once connected, the power button will start to blink. This indicates successful connection to a power source and the grill has entered standby mode.
6. Turn on the grill by pressing the power button. The button will light up continuously, indicating it is ready for grilling.



7. Press your preferred heat button, depending on the level required for the food you're going to grill:
 - **HEAT PRESERVATION - 80°C:** Keeps food warm without further cooking.
 - **LOW HEAT - 125°C TO 135°C:** Gentle cooking for delicate foods, slow-roasted meats, or vegetables.
 - **MEDIUM HEAT - 165°C TO 180°C:** Everyday cooking for prawns, fish fillets, sausages, and grilled vegetables.
 - **HIGH HEAT - 200°C TO 220°C:** High heat for searing steaks, BBQ pizza, toasting bread, or wraps.



8. Place the silicone drip towards the drain hole and lightly oil the grill surface.



9. Place the food on the plate. Monitor while cooking and use non-metal utensils such as silicone, wood, or heat-resistant plastic when adding, removing, or flipping your foods.



10. After cooking, turn off the grill using the power button and disconnect from the power supply. Allow the plate to cool completely before disassembling, cleaning, and storing.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

- Switch off the grill and disconnect it from the power supply before cleaning. Allow the grill and cooking plate to cool completely.
- Empty the silicone drip tray and wipe off any grease or food residue. Wash the drip tray with warm water and mild dish soap, then rinse and dry thoroughly.
- Use a soft cloth or sponge and mild dish soap to gently wipe the ceramic cooking surface. Avoid abrasive scrubbers or harsh chemicals that could damage the coating.
- Wipe the outside of the grill with a damp cloth and mild dish soap if needed. Do not immerse the grill in water or any other liquid.
- Rinse with clean water if soap was used, then dry completely with a soft cloth.
- Ensure all parts are fully dry before reassembling or storing.
- Store the grill in the included Oxford carry bag in a cool, dry place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

No power detected even when plugged into a power source.	• Check that the outlet is working by plugging in another device, or try a different power source. • Ensure the plug is fully inserted. • If the power source is an inverter, make sure it is rated at 2000W or higher and check if the battery is sufficiently charged. • Check the condition of the cable for any visible damage such as frayed wires or loose fittings, as this may prevent proper connection. If the cable is damaged, contact KickAss Products customer support.
Food sticks on the ceramic plate.	• Lightly oil the plate before cooking; clean the plate thoroughly after each use to remove residue. • Use non-metal utensils such as silicone, wood, or heat-resistant plastic.
There is an excess of oil, grease and liquid drippings.	• The grill is designed to drain excess oil or liquid. Ensure the provided silicone drip tray is pointed correctly to the drain hole and check that the tray is not warped or bent.
